Although Chinweizu et al, the authors of Toward the Decolonization of African Literature, declare that “we are not evaluating Jagua Nana, but instead are analyzing and evaluating Palmer's criticism of it”, they invariably end as the greatest defenders of Ekwensi's novel, especially in relation to the charge of weakness in moral vision. As Chinweizu et al argue, “for Palmer, Jagua is an Immoral Woman; she especially irks him by showing no remorse for her ways.
