APOE e2 — the least common — appears to reduce the risk of Alzheimer's.; APOE e4 — a little more common — increases the risk of Alzheimer's.; APOE e3 — the most common — doesn't seem to affect the risk of Alzheimer's; Genes aren't the only factor. Because you inherit one APOE gene from your mother and another from your father, you have two copies of the APOE gene.

Sundowning isn't a disease, but a group of symptoms that occur at a specific time of the day that may affect people with dementia, such as Alzheimer's disease. The exact cause of this behavior is unknown.
