The new Act uses the term fraudulent " act " rather than claim. In a situation where a fraudulent act has been committed and payments are made because the insurer has not discovered it but they then go on to discover the fraudulent " act " there is no statutory remedy. The Law Commission recommend a self-help remedy of express provisions.

It is trite law that a contract induced by fraudulent misrepresentation can be set aside. That applies also to a settlement contract following an insurance claim. That situation should be distinguished from that in which the insurer is aware of fraud but chooses to settle.

ISA 240 the Auditor's Responsibilities Relating to Fraud in an Audit of Financial Statements recognises that misstatement in the financial statements can arise from either fraud or error. The distinguishing factor is whether the underlying action that resulted in the misstatement was intentional or unintentional.
